PART A - MP3 Audio Recording & Soundtrap Shared File

STEP 1: Go to STILE and open **YEAR 9 MUSIC 2021** class

STEP 2: Scroll down and click on **UNIT THREE: EDM - Creative Repetition**

STEP 3: Click on **ASSESSMENT TASK#3 NOTIFICATION & UPLOAD ZONE**

STEP 4: Scroll down to **ASSESSMENT TASK THREE (PART A) RECORDING & ARRANGEMENT UPLOAD ZONE**

STEP 5: Upload your completed **SOUNDTRAP** file here (there are a number of ways that this can be done depending on the device you are using to upload. Please see Mr Denham for assistance if required **BEFORE** the due date to ensure that the upload is successful)

STEP 6: Share your Soundtrap File with Mr Denham (*this should take place from the beginning of the composition process*)

Task Requirements:

Composition (Hand in)

Outcomes: 5.4, 5.5, 5.6, 5.10

Weighting: 30% - Mark out of 20

STEP ONE - Create a piece of electronic dance music (2-3 minutes in length) using cut-and-paste, editing and looping techniques in **Soundtrap** on your device.

- Your composition **MUST** contain elements of the House EDM style. It **MUST** also use a **MINIMUM** of **ONE** of the Fr Bob Maguire audio samples on homelessness provided in STILE as vocal samples that form the creative fabric of the composition.
- Your composition **MUST** consist of the following sections: Mix-In, Main Section (Section A), Breakdown & Drop (Section B), Main Section (Section A Reprise) and Mix-Out.

NOTE: Use only percussion in the mix-in and mix-out. All but one of the tracks should drop out at the start of the breakdown section and slowly build back up to a climax.

- Use **Soundtrap** on your device to create **FIVE** (or more) tracks. You **MUST** include a **percussion/rhythm track** (this can be a combination of apple loops), a **vocal sample** (Fr Bob excerpts), **a melodic track**, **a harmonic track** and a **bass line track**.

IMPORTANT DETAILS:

- 1.) The bass line **MUST** be the same as your EDM Class Project completed in class -

C - Bb - Ab - C - Eb - F - F - Ab - C - Eb - F

- 2.) The harmony and melody **MUST** be created from the **C natural minor scale**
- 3.) The structure of your composition **MUST** consist of **8 BAR LOOPS**. Section A is to consist of an A THEME and contrasting B THEME (In the relative Major key Eb Major).
- 4.) **ALL** except the percussion/rhythm track and vocal sample track are to be composed by you and **notated using Noteflight notation software**.

STEP TWO - Export your final **Soundtrap** composition and upload into **STILE (PART A)**. Don't forget to share the Soundtrap file with your class teacher!

- All notated parts are to be uploaded from **Noteflight** into STILE as separate **PDF files (PART B)**. Both parts are of **EQUAL** value and will be marked accordingly.

NOTE: Your composition recording might be used as part of a dance party style lunch concert performance.

Marking Criteria:

You will be marked on your ability to:

- Demonstrates an understanding of the concepts of music as evident in the composed work
- Composes a work representative of the topic showing an awareness of style (EDM)
- Effectively uses sequencing software in the composition process to effectively arrange ideas
- Effectively uses notation software in the composition process showing an understanding of score conventions and musical literacy
